INTRODUCTION

The RCP8 Universal Remote Control by CREST Electronics with Dynamic Database Technology™ is the latest generation universal remote designed specifically for the Australian market place.

Consolidating your remote controls has never been easier. With the RCP8's preprogrammed library of codes for TV's, VCR's DVD, Satellite converters, Audio and learning, consolidation is only steps away. Please read the enclosed instructions carefully and retain for future use.

INSTALLING BATTERIES

1. Pull back the remote controls battery cover and remove it
2. Insert two (2) new "AAA" batteries according to the + and -marks in the battery case
3. Push the battery cover back into place
4. Test the unit by pressing the Power key. If the batteries are inserted properly LED will light

NOTE: When the batteries need to be replaced, the remote control will stop working. Replace the old batteries and the unit will be restored to its full functionality

FEATURES AND FUNCTIONS



Use the POWER key to turn on or off the selected device.



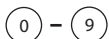
Use the Device Select left and right keys to change the device being controlled.



Press the 16:9 key to change the aspect ratio/picture format on your TV (Not available on all TV's)



Press the SLEEP key to activate the sleep timer of your TV. (Not available on all TV's)



The digit keys are used to program the remote control and operate identically as your remote controls



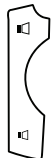
Use the AV key to change the Video input on your TV



Use the -/-- to switch between one and two digit channel entry



Press the MUTE key to turn on or off the sound of the selected device



Use VOL + (or VOL-) keys to raise or lower the sound of the selected device



Press the Return key to switch between two programs



Use the CH + (or CH-) keys to the select the next higher or lower channel



Use the CURSOR keys to navigate and select items in the on screen menu or guide

FEATURES AND FUNCTIONS



Use the MENU key to access the on screen menu or guide of your TV, VCR, DVD or Satellite



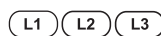
The Red, Green, Blue and Yellow Keys allow you to access the Fast-Text functions of your TV as well as additional functions of your Satellite (Fast-Text is not available on all TV's)



The Teletext keys are used to access the teletext features on your TV (Teletext is not available on all TV's, please consult the owners manual of your TV for complete operation)



The PLAY, STOP, REWIND, FAST FWD, REWIND and RECORD keys operate identically as your original DVD or VCR remote control



The L1, L2 and L3 keys are Dedicated learning keys (see Page 6)

DEVICE PROGRAMMING

The Crest RCP5 Universal Remote Control come pre-programmed with the most popular TV, VCR, DVD, Satellite and Audio codes used in Australia.

1. Turn on the Device to be programmed
2. Use the Device Select Left or Device Select Right keys to select the device you want to program.
3. Press and hold SETUP key for 3 sec until LED flashes twice and release SETUP key
4. Enter 4 Digit Number as per the information shown in Brand list
5. If the Setup is OK, the LED will flash 2 times.
6. Aim the remote at the device and press Power, if the device turns off you have found the correct code. If the device does not respond, repeat steps 3 through 5 using the next code listed for your brand.

CODE SEARCH

If the device you are trying to program does not work with the codes listed or if your brand is not listed try code search

1. Turn On the target Device
2. Use the Device Select Left or Right keys to select the device you want to learn the new function.
3. Press and hold SETUP key until LED flashes 2 times to and release SETUP key.
4. Press the MUTE and OK key at the same time, the LED will flash 2 times and remain ON to indicate the SEARCH mode is ready
5. Aim the Remote control at the device and press the Cursor Up key. If the device turns off, immediately stop and move on to step 6.

If the device does not respond, continue pressing and releasing the Cursor Up key until the device turns off

6. Press and release the OK key to store and save the code

-If you cannot control the device properly, you might have found the incorrect code and will need to continue searching until you find the code that works properly.

PROGRAMMING A SECOND TV

With the new Crest RCP8 universal remote control, you can program any device type under any device position. This remote control utilize a device identifier to determine what type of device you are programming. The device type identifiers are as follows:

0= TV	1= SATELLITE or TOP-BOX
2=DVD	3=VCR
4=AUDIO	5=CD

For example, to program a second TV under the SAT device position follow these instructions:

1. Turn on the TV to be programmed
2. Use the Device Select Left or Right keys to select SAT
3. Press and hold SETUP key until LED flash 2 times and release SETUP key
4. Enter 4 Digit Number as per the information shown in Brand list
5. If the Setup is OK, the LED will flash 2 times.
6. Aim the remote at the device and press Power, if the Device turns off you have found the correct code. If the device does not respond, repeat steps 3 through 6

ACTIVATING VOLUME LOCK

Volume lock will allow you to select the source in which you want to control the volume. For example, if you always use the TV to control the volume, you can configure the RCP8 so that regardless what device mode is selected (e.g. VCR, DVD or SAT), when you press the volume +/- or Mute keys you will always have control of the TV's volume. To activate volume lock, use the following instructions:

1. Press and hold the SETUP key until LED flashes twice and release SETUP key
2. Press the desired Device Type number (0: TV, 1: SAT/CAB, 2: DVD , 3: VCR, 4: AUDIO, 5: CD or 7: AV2).
3. Press Vol up key, The LED will flash twice

DE-ACTIVATING VOLUME LOCK

1. Press and hold SETUP key until LED flashes twice and release the SETUP key
2. Press SETUP and Mute at the same time, the LED will flash twice

LEARNING

The RCP8 includes a powerful learning feature to allow optimal customization of your new universal remote control. This feature will allow you to add unique functions from your original remote control onto the RCP8 for the complete solution in controlling all of your audio video devices.

1. Use the Device Select Left or Right keys to select the device you want to learn the new function
2. Press and Hold in the SETUP and MENU keys together until the LED under the selected device starts flashing.
3. Press the desired key (e.g. L1, L2 or L3 or any other key) until LED stays lit
4. Point the original remote to the front part of the RCP8, Press the desired key to learn on the original remote control.
5. When Capture of the code is successful, LED will show a SLOW flashing , after that it will indicate the normal flashing cycle of Learning mode

LEARNING CONT...

6. Repeat the above procedure until all the desired code has been learned.
7. To exit the learning mode, press and hold the SETUP and MENU keys and release.
8. To Learn keys into under a different device mode, repeat steps 1 through 7 substituting the new device in step 1.

-The RCP8 can store over 60 learned keys in its memory

-Learned keys can only be transmitted from the mode in which they were learned

-Due to the varying frequencies used to control devices, it is possible that some commands cannot be learned properly.

DELETING A LEARNED KEY

1. Use the Device Select Left or Right keys to select the device you want to learn the new function.
2. Press and Hold in the SETUP and MENU keys together until the LED under the selected device starts flashing.
3. Press and hold down the device select left key and the key to be deleted until the led flashes twice and release both keys.
4. Repeat step 3 to continue deleting keys.
5. Press and release SETUP + MENU to exit.

DELETING ALL LEARNED KEYS FROM DEVICE

1. Use the Device Select Left or Right keys to select the device you want to learn the new function.
2. Press and Hold in the SETUP and MENU keys together until the LED under the selected device starts flashing.
3. Press and hold down the device select left key and the device select right key until the led flashes three times and release both keys

ACTIVATING/DE-ACTIVATING BACKLIGHTING

With the RCP8, you can easily activate and deactivate the backlight feature with the following sequence:

DEACTIVATE BACKLIGHTING

1. Press and hold in RED + BLUE until backligt turns off.

ACTIVATE BACKLIGHTING

1. Press and hold in RED + BLUE until backlight turns on.

HOME THEATRE CONTROL

With the RCP8, you have the ability to setup a home theatre mode to easily control the most used features of your home theatre devices. The functions controlled are broken up into four groups as follows:

KEY GROUP	KEYS ASSOCIATED
Channel Control	Digits 0-9, -/-, Power, CH+/-, SLEEP, AV, 16:9
Volume Control	Volume +/-, Mute
Menu Navigation	Menu, OK, Up, Down, Left, Right, R, G, Y, B
Transport Control	Fast Fwd, Rewind, Play, Stop, Pause, Record

For Example, if you want the Channel Control to be set to the SAT mode, Volume to the AV1 mode, Menu to SAT mode and transport operation to the DVD mode follow these instructions:

1. Press the Device Select left or right key to select the HT mode.
2. Press and hold in the SETUP key until the LED flashes 2 times and release the SETUP key.
3. Press and release the OK key and the LED under HT will flash
4. Press the Device Select left or right key until the LED under SAT and HT are flashing.
5. Press and release the CH+ keys to select Channel Control Group for SAT mode.
6. Press and release the Cursor Up Key to select the Menu Navigation Group for SAT mode.
7. Press the Device Select left or right key until the LED under AV1 and HT are flashing.
8. Press and release the Volume + key to select the Volume Group for AV1.
9. Press the Device Select left or right key until the LED under DVD and HT are flashing.
10. Press and release the Play key to select the Transport Group for DVD.
11. Press and release the OK key to save your setting.

Note: Now when you select the HT mode, the groups of keys will operate the device you associated them with in the above steps.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

PROBLEM: The Red LED does not blink when you press a key.

SOLUTION: Replace the batteries with two (2) new AAA batteries.

TROUBLE SHOOTING CONT...

PROBLEM: The LED blinks when you press a key, but the device does not respond.

SOLUTION: Make sure the remote control is aimed at the device you are trying to operate

PROBLEM: The remote control does not control the device selected or the commands are not working properly.

SOLUTION: Try all listed codes for the device being set up. Make sure they can be operated with an infrared remote control

30-DAY LIMITED DOUBLE YOUR MONEY BACK GUARANTEE

Crest Electronics guarantees for a period of 30 days from date of the original purchase to the original consumer purchaser.

That the RCP8 Universal Remote Control will control any INFRARED remote- controlled TV, VCR, DVD or Satellite Receiver manufactured for retail sale in Australia.

In the event that your RCP8 Universal Remote Control will not control your Device(s), you must call our National Toll-Free Number 1 800 812 261 and provide the following Information:

- a) Date of Original Purchase.
- b) Name of Retail Location.
- c) Manufacturer's Name and Model number of the device(s) that the RCP8 Universal Remote Control will not control.

Upon the receipt of the above information Crest Electronics, will determine at that time if we can provide you with another Universal Remote Control that will control your device(s). If we can provide you with another universal remote control that will control all of your devices, we will ask you to: Return to Crest Electronics the RCP8 Universal Remote Control (in good working condition) together with the original packaging and all materials, along with your proof of retail purchase the, original manufacturers' remote (in good wroking condition) and model number of the device(s) the RCP8 Universal Remote Control will not control.

If Crest Electronics determines that it cannot provide you with a remote control that will control all of your devices you will be required to:

Upon receipt of your RCP8 Universal Remote Control and, Crest Electronics will send you a cheque for double the retail amount paid by you for the purchase of the RCP8 Universal Remote Control.

The Following Important Information:

- a). This guarantee shall only be applicable for retail purchasers of INFRARED remote-controlled Device(s) excluding Audio Receivers manufactured for retail sale in Australia or New Zealand

b). This guarantee does not apply to any defective product (to which our normal warranty applies) and any product damaged by accident, misuse, abuse, improper battery installation, fire, water, lightning, or other acts of God. This guarantee does not cover cartons, carrying cases, batteries, broken or marred cabinets, missing packaging or missing instructions.

c). This guarantee only applies to the original purchaser of the RCP8 Universal Remote Control and does not apply to any product after the initial 30 days from the date of retail purchase to the original retail purchaser and this offer is limited to one (1) refund per family.

This guarantee specifically excludes:

- Non-remote operated TV's, VCR's, DVD's and Satellite/Cable Receiver boxes.
- Wired remote operated TV's, VCR's, DVD's and Satellite/Cable Receiver boxes.
- All TV's, VCR's, DVD's and Satellite/Cable Receivers Not mfg. for use in Australia by an ABA licensed service provider
- Products that operate over 100kHz (Bang & Olufsen)
- Any peculiarity due to the original manufacturer's design such as channel up and down on some models of TV
- Commercial use of product (eg. Retail outlets, hotels/motels, schools etc.)
- Only basic TV functions are applicable (per device)

TV: volume Up/Down, mute, channel +/-, power, digits 0-9, AV, Menu and Navigation Keys

VCR: power, 0-9 digits, channel up, channel down, play, stop, forward, rewind, record, pause, TV/VCR
